How can I get started?


Step 1: Contact our Study Coordinator to learn more about the study and see if you are eligible. Contact information is on the inside of this brochure.

Step 2: Determine if you are eligible and give Informed Consent

The study team will explain the study procedures and the potential benefits and risks. To join the study, you must read and sign a document called an informed consent.

Step 3: Participate

If eligible, you will enter the study for 18 months. After getting the study treatment, you will visit the site 7 days later and then once a month.


Study Investigational Treatment:

INFORMATION ABOUT THE STUDY

Study Criteria

- Age ≥ 45 years
- Diagnosed with DMO or RVO in one or both eyes
- Not eligible if you are currently taking steroid therapy.

If you qualify for the study, you will receive the following at no cost:

- Study treatment
- Study-related care from your study doctor
- \$250 for each study visit to cover costs such as travel and meals
