Pupil assessment



EYE EMERGENCIES AND THE RED EYE

RETINAL DETACHMENT

STRABISMUS IN CHILDREN

Use of an ophthalmoscope and toys to check a baby's vision and check for a squint in a child



EYELID: ASSESSMENT OF A LID POSITION AND LESIONS

- Eyelid eversion to identify aetiology
- Safely taping eyelids to reduce exposure risk
